Spain: “Spanish police have escorted thousands of lorries carrying supplies to markets and cleared roads of blockades set up by hauliers striking over fuel prices”.

Because of the fuel crisis in Spain shortages of supplies at Madrid’s main produce markets are being reported. Unions representing 88% of Spain’s lorry drivers, call for tax relief, emergency credit and other measures to ease the economic impact of higher fuel prices. Portugal’s government granted the strikers a tax relief and reduced motorway tolls for lorry drivers to compensate for expensive fuel. **European Fuel Protests are in: Belgium, Bulgaria, France, Italy, Portugal, Spain, India, UK.**
