Winterizing Your Truck

Cold-Weather Checklist

Once again, *IT'S WINTER*; it's time to do your winter checklist for cold-weather operations and maintenance procedures. There are some recommendations that all truckers can follow.

Coolant

Winterizing the cooling system means flushing and checking for leaks.
Antifreeze for diesels.

Oil

Cold engines need adequate time to warm up in cold weather. Make sure you choose a good motor oil for the best performance in cold temperatures.

Chassis and Lube

Chassis and driveline greasing is always important. Keeping these components lubricated will help prevent contamination from slush and road chemicals.

Belts and Hoses

Belt and hose condition is important anytime, but it can be critical in cold temperatures. Replacing cracked, worn, swollen or dried-out belts and hoses is extremely important.

Battery

Cold weather puts extra demands on your batteries, and can reduce their performance and output. A battery load test can avoid a jump-start in cold-weather.

There are more general items to check: windshield wipers and washer reservoir, fan blade, fan belt and clutch.
