## **FUEL THEFT**

### **Common Sense Advice**

When you are at fuel island topping off your tank, be aware of cheap freight haulers with ill intent hanging around. A few have siphon pumps capable of completely drawing out a full 150-gallon tank of fuel within 10 to 15 minutes. When parking do not leave your truck unattended for long periods of time. Fuel your truck when you begin your run for the day of driving and immediately before you leave. If you leave your truck unattended, at home, break, hotel or repair – make it a point to leave it there with as little fuel as possible. **REMINDE YOURSELF TO FUEL UP BEFORE YOU LEAVE!**
