Ice Road Truckers

It's June HOT SUMMER TIME. This newsletter is about those Ice Road Truckers in the Northwest Territories of Canada in the wintertime. The Ice Road Truckers runs back and forth to Edmonton, Alberta to get the fuel that is stored in Yellowknife to be hauled to the diamond mines the next ice road season. They haul over frozen lakebeds that can crack under them at any time. They run from late January till March from yellowknife, Northeast Terrtories, to the diamond mines and gold mines.

The haul begins in January or February, depending upon the weather. The trucks haul as much as they can during the ice road season. It's a dangerous job if rules aren't followed. Like the trucks aren't to drive to close to each other for safety reasons. When the rules are followed and the ice is monitored and the drivers are alert.

The diamond mines are about 255 miles takes 2 and half days round-trip. Driving about 19-25 mph.
