### **10 Tips for Truck Tire Safety**

- 1. Check tires for correct air pressures. Drivers should have an accurate pressure gauge.**
- 2. Conduct a visual inspection of your vehicle's tires prior to operation. Look for wear in the treads and shoulder of the tires.**
- 3. Check the vehicle's owner's manual for the precise air pressure.**
- 4. Check tires for correct air pressure.**
- 5. Be sure to wash your tires.**
- 6. Check every tire on the tractor and trailer – including inside dual tires (and mounted spare if the truck has one).**
- 7. Properly store tires when they are not in use.**
- 8. Never supply heat to the wheel when the tire is mounted.**
- 9. Always use a safety cage when inflating tires after mounting.**

## **10. Tire and rim servicing should be done by trained personnel.**
